a learning and working experience for high school seniors and juniors.



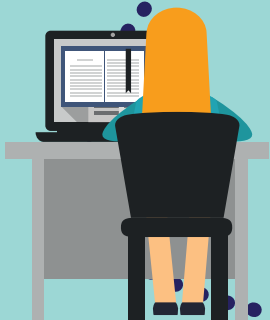
For six months, the student will attend seminars from experts in the field of social and criminal justice.
